Preliminary Information

Date:

February 6-14, 2009

Venue:

Regional Scout Training Centre, Bahadurpur, Gazipur, Bangladesh. (45 kilometers north of Dhaka city and only an hour journey from Zia International Airport)

Theme:

Rovering for Leadership.

Reporting and Departure:

All participants are requested to report on 7 February 2009 and depart on 14 February 2009.

Registration Fees :

Each participant should pay US\$ 100.00 as the registration fee. We encourage more participants to camp the event. Registration fee per participant for the SAARC countries is US\$ 50.00. Registration fee covers the inland transportation to and from the Zia International Airport, Camp Souvenir, Scarf, Moot Badge, Waggle and Food.

Programme Highlights:

Accommodation:

Bangladesh Scouts has decided to accommodate all the participants in tents. For this, the participants have to bring necessary things, such as sleeping bag and other necessary belongings. Tent for group accommodation will be provided.

Food:

Cooked food will be provided to the foreign participants.

Entry Visa:

After getting the list of participants' and passport details, Bangladesh Scouts will send the formal visa request letter to the concerned Embassies of Bangladesh for issuing visa. All participants are requested to contact nearest Embassy of Bangladesh and apply for visa as per rule.

Home Hospitality:

Home hospitality may be arranged in case of prior request.

Registration Kit:

Each participant will be provided with a scarf, a badge, a waggle and an identity tag with a nice folder.

Airport Reception:

Display Board:

Each NSO will get a board for display its scouting and country profile. The size of the board will be 1 meter x 1 meter.

Weather:

The weather of Bahadurpur in January will be pleasant. The temperature will be around 10 Degree Centigrade at night and around 10-15 Degree Centigrade at daytime. Light warm clothes will be required at night.

Things to Bring:

Participants are requested to bring Scout uniform, NSO Flag, National Flag, a CD of National Anthem, sleeping bags, blanket, personal toiletries, shorts, personal medicine, torch or flashlight, light warm clothes and other necessary belongings.
